- Increased delivery of rental stock through social housing.
- Acquisition of well-locate land for human settlements development.
- Implementation of several catalytic human settlements development projects in areas identified for spatial transformation and in deprived areas.
- Title deeds programme to ensure security of tenure for many South Africans who never owned a property before.
