The MEC's will be in the company of the Executive Mayor of Nkomazi Local Municipality, Cllr Phindile Magagula and Ehlanzeni District Executive Mayor, Cllr Terrence Shabangu and the representative of the House of Traditional and Khoi-San Leaders.
