Profile of Ms. Landulile Cathrine Dlamini has an extensive experience in management, leadership, monitoring and evaluation, Local Government, Provincial Government, National Government and Private sector as well as Facilitation and Public Participation.

From 1994-1997 she was appointment as a Provincial HIV and AIDS Coordinator by Department of Health and Population Development. She was the youngest member of the Strategic

Management Team representing Department of Health, to build Mpumalanga Province before and after elections

From 1997-2011 she was appointment in the Office of the Premier first as Deputy Director: Civil Society Participation and Liaison in Governance and later as Senior Manager: Monitoring and Evaluation.

Ms. Dlamini was Elected the first Black Mayor and first Female Mayor in Greater Malelane TLC and participated in the Local Government Association of Mpumalanga (LOGAM). She was elected Secretary of the Gender working group, member of Training and Labour Working Group. She represented Greater Malelane in the Lowveld Escarpment District.

In 2006, she was elected as a Councillor for the Ehlanzeni District Council where she served for two terms as the Chairperson of the Woman's Council.

From 2011-2014, she served as the Executive Mayor: Mbombela Local Municipality, the Capital City of Mpumalanga Province.

From 2014-2019, she served as a Member of Parliament of the Republic of South Africa in the Council of Provinces where she was elected a Chairperson of the Select Committee on Social Service with the Departments of Health, Human Settlement, Social Development, Water and Sanitation and Home Affairs.
